### To install the Carmelite Digital Library on your PC:

Download the CDL\_StTeresa\_StJohn\_2.1-setup.exe file onto your computer.

- 1. If you have Version 1.0 of St. John of the Cross, uninstall it before continuing.
- 2. If you have Version 2.0 of Carmelite Digital Library, uninstall it before continuing.
- 3. Double click on the file "CDL StTeresa StJohn 2.1-setup.exe"
- 4. Answer the prompts and the program will be installed on your machine. You may need Administrator rights to complete the installation.
- 5. Upon completion of this installation, you will be able to search across both St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross.
